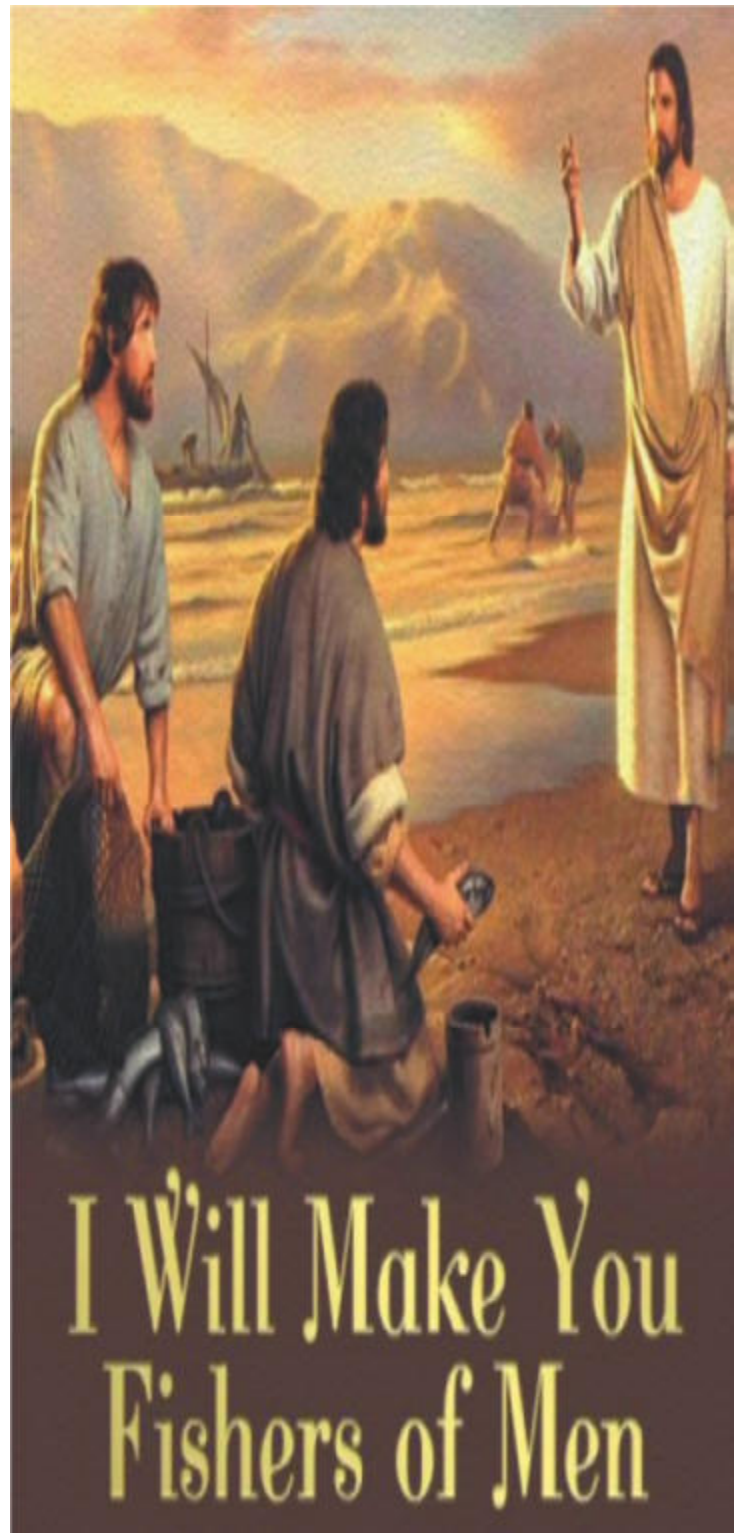

### **LENTEN SEASON**

It is hard to believe that Lent is fast approaching. Ash Wednesday is February 17, 2021. This year, due to COVID-19, the imposition of ashes on a person’s forehead will not be done. Rather, the European custom of sprinkling ashes on the crown of a person’s head will be used.

*Sprinkling ashes on the crown of the head recalls the biblical method of putting on sackcloth and ashes as a sign of penance: “now on the twenty-fourth day of this month the people of Israel were assembles with fasting and in sackcloth, and with earth upon their heads” (Neh 9:1).*
