My dear parish family:

This weekend we celebrate the great Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the great mystery of One God, yet three Divine Persons. We are all baptized in the name of Blessed Trinity, Father, Son and Spirit. In this Blessed Trinity we breath, live and have life. We continue to pray and grow in our faith each day.

The obligation to attend Holy Mass on the Lord's Day is a sacred one. Anyone who is frail or at risk due to advanced age or medical conditions is *always* excused from this obligation, and we encouraged you to use your prudential judgement throughout this pandemic to determine if it was unsafe for you to attend Mass. This remains true.

However, for those who are healthy and not at great risk, the presumption of the faithful should be that, unless they are at an enhanced risk, sick, or caring for others who are at risk or sick, *the obligation to attend Sunday Mass now resumes, effective the weekend of June 5-6, 2021, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Chris in our dioceses.*

Let's be welcoming to our brothers and sisters when they return to Mass. Spacing requirements and mask guidelines must still be followed.

Know of my continued daily prayers for all of you and my thanks to all the parishioners who continue to support our parish. Your continued support is greatly appreciated by me and I am sure your fellow family members in the family at Resurrection.
