FAITH FORMATION NEWS

As we are enjoying summer and happily returning to pre-Covid-19 normalcy, it is time to think about the 2021-2022 Faith Formation school year.

As you know, last year we had many things planned which would have allowed the students to experience the rites of the Catholic Church. However, the Covid-19 restrictions for faith formation classes were cost prohibitive. Additionally, due to the demolition of the school building, the utilities to the Malikowski Center had to be shut off.

The purpose of Life Long Faith Formation is to have student realize that faith formation is not just text book learning to receive a sacrament, but Catholic Education that prepares you for life. Faith Formation provides the student with Catholic tools that enables them to face life's challenges by employing God's help. The education obtained from these classes allows the student to experience the beautiful rites of the Catholic Church such as the Mass on Holy Thursday and the Easter Vigil Mass.

Currently the plans for Faith Formation are to have the classes in the Malikowski Center. Grades 1 through 5 will be conducted on Wednesday evenings from 6 PM to 7 PM. Grades 6 through 10 will have classes on Thursday from 6 PM to 7 PM. At this time the start date will be Wednesday, September 15 and Thursday, September 16.

RETROUVAILLE HELP FOR YOUR MARRIAGE

This program is for couples with marital problems that want marriage help. Those who are considering marriage separation and those who are already separated or divorced are encouraged to consider Retrouvaille. There is always hope of reviving your relationship.

The Retrouvaille program is for husbands and wives and is NOT designed for couples in a cohabitating relationship.

Some couples come to Retrouvaille during the initial signs of a marriage problem. Other couples are in a state of despair and hopelessness when they attend the program. Many lawyers and judges send couples to Retrouvaille as a prerequisite to filing for a divorce or rendering final decisions.

Many marriage counselors and family therapists send their clients to Retrouvaille as a prerequisite to counseling. These professionals know that the tools of communication in marriage taught in the program are often what couples need.
