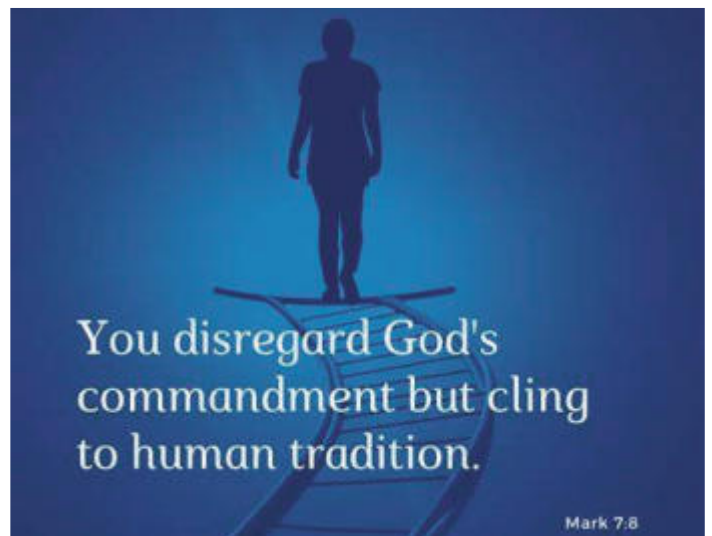

RETROUVAILLE HELP FOR YOUR MARRIAGE

Retrouvaille begins with a weekend experience in which couples are helped to reestablish communication and to gain insights into themselves as individuals and a couple. Weekends are typically held at either a local hotel or a retreat facility. This part of the program is presented by three couples and a priest team. The presenting team has experienced disillusionment, pain, and conflict in their own lives and offer hope as they share their personal struggles of reconciliation and healing.

You will find courage and strength in the realization that you are not alone in your struggle. You will not be asked to share your problems with anyone else. However, you will be encouraged to put the past behind you and to look beyond the hurt and pain, in order to rediscover each other in a new and positive way. The Retrouvaille Weekend provides tools to help couples with communication, forgiveness, and trust. It teaches a dialogue process of meaningful communication.

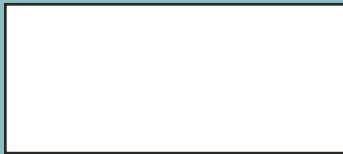
