Saint Francis was born in 1182 in the city of Assisi. He was the son of a wealthy family. His father was a cloth merchant.

In his youth, Francis loved to have a good time. He loved to party, drink and indulged in fine food, wine and wild celebrations. He was a confirmed sinner. By the age of 14, he left school and became known as a rebellious teenager known for carousing and breaking curfew.

His privileged life allowed him to excel in archery and horsemanship. When war broke out he took his place with the cavalry. After being captured by the enemy, he was held in prison. While there Francis heard our Lord calling him to follow him. Francis was inspired. His previous lifestyle no longer appealed to him. Francis began to visit hospitals and attend to the sick.
