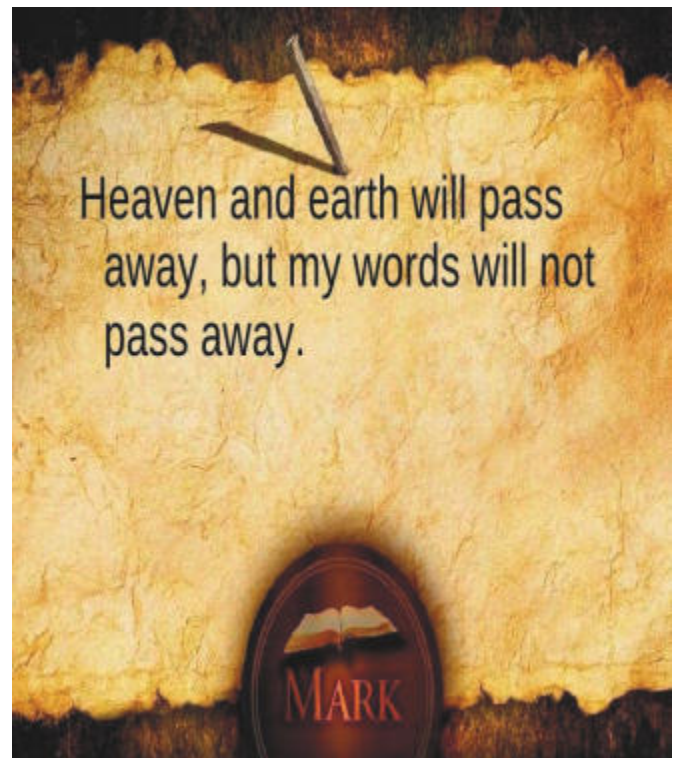

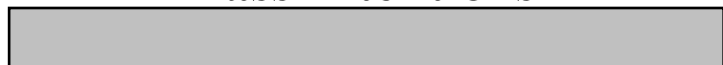

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. THERESA

THE LITTLE FLOWER OF JESUS

Marie-Francoise-Theresa Martin was born in France in 1873. She lived a life of refinements and comfort that would have spoiled an ordinary child. Theresa was one of 5 children all girls. She was intelligent which allowed her to comprehend God’s goodness far in advance of her years.

Tragedy struck early in her life. Her mother died of breast cancer and her sister Pauline became her second mother.

Theresa became ill with an illness for which there seemed to be no cure. She had confidence in God and overcame her infirmity. Theresa adopted flowers as the symbol of her love for the Divine Savior and offered her practices of virtue, sacrifice as flowers at the feet of Jesus.

At fifteen, Theresa entered the Carmelite Convent at Lisieux. Because of her young age, she had to obtain special permission which she received. She differentiated herself by strict adherence to punctuality and the rules. She also had a burning love for God and explicit trust in him.

Theresa contracted tuberculous and died on September 30, 1897.

Since her death countless graces have been attributed to her intercession. She was declared Blessed by Pope Pius XI. Theresa was canonized a saint May 17, 1925.
