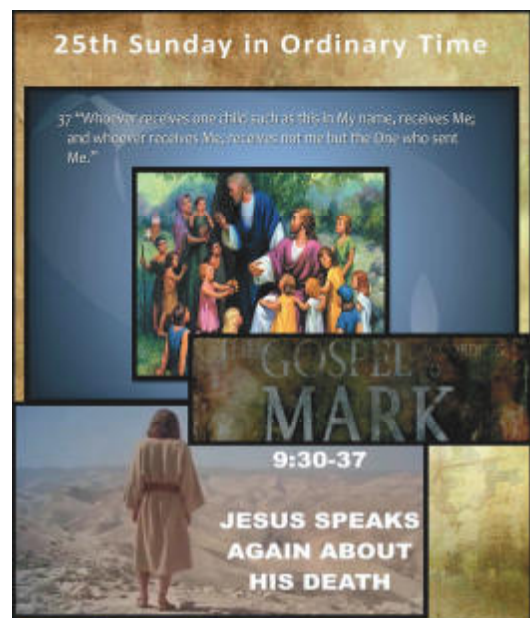

BIG MONEY RAFFLE UPDATE

Fundraisers, such as theme trays, raffles, and dinners, are organized to raise money to cover operating expenses at our parish. Over the years, many of these events were successfully held at the Monsignor Malikowski Center and enjoyed by those that attended.

Unfortunately, in the last couple of years, Covid and the demolition of the school building forced the cancelation of many of the in-person events. A few, such as the Big Money Raffle and the Meat Raffle, were held remotely.

While ticket sales started out strong this year, averaging 50 per week, the weekly average has dropped dramatically over the last month to 20 per week. With less than 2 months until the raffle, ticket sales are lagging far behind last year's total of 865. As of this past weekend (9/12), a total of only 445 tickets have been sold.

The annual Big Money Raffle has become our major fundraising event of the year. Please consider selling tickets to family, friends, or coworkers. The raffle depends on YOUR support. Please do what you can to make it a success.
