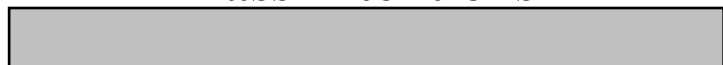

BIG MONEY RAFFLE UPDATE

Fundraisers, such as theme trays, raffles, and dinners, are organized to raise money to cover operating expenses at our parish. Over the years, many of these events were successfully held at the Monsignor Malikowski Center and enjoyed by those that attended.

Unfortunately, in the last couple of years, Covid and the demolition of the school building forced the cancelation of many of the in-person events. A few, such as the Big Money Raffle and the Meat Raffle, were held remotely.

While ticket sales started out strong this year, averaging 50 per week, the weekly average has dropped dramatically over the last month to 20 per week. With less than 2 months until the raffle, ticket sales are lagging far behind last year's total of 865. As of this past weekend (9/19), a total of only 479 tickets have been sold.

OCTOBER THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

October is dedicated to the rosary which is a very powerful prayer. The Blessed Mother has asked us to pray the rosary daily. She revealed this to the world when she appeared to the three children at Fatima: Lucia Dos Santos age 9, and her cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, ages 8 and 6 respectively. They tended the sheep and every day during their lunch they prayed the rosary.

The first apparition was on the 13th of May 1917. The Blessed Mother requested that the children appear on the 13th of the month for the next six months. During one of the apparitions the Blessed Mother requested that **"that you continue to recite the Rosary every day to our Lady of the Rosary to obtain peace in the world and the end of the war, because only She will be able to aid you."**

In view of the situation in the world today with conflicts, mistreatment of people, religious persecutions, people embracing materialism rather than turning to God and trusting in Him, this is an excellent time to pray the rosary. Please say the rosary daily.
